GUIDELINES FOR MILITARY STREET PARADE COMPETITION

- The Corp Commander and Staff will lead their respective units, followed by the majorettes, DBC – LYRE Corps and Model Company.
- Military Police (MP's) and other individual escorting your unit EXCEPT the commandant are Strictly Prohibited to enter or pass within the competition area. Committee members, regular policeman, civil security unit of the city are authorized to stay at the perimeter of the Ceremonial Grandstand.
- Actual practice at the reviewing stand (in-front of the City Ceremonial Grandstand) **is not allowed**. Except for Elementary Majorettes & DBC – Lyre Corp pass.
- UNIFORM Gala, fatigue or other attire authorized by Dep-Ed/AFP. Hence, uniform ID NOT included in the criteria for judging.
- Formation for Military group – initials in column formation from the starting point, and from column of platoon in line when passing the reviewing stand.
- Each school/unit is required to bring SCHOOL COLOR together with BEARER with – Minimum height of 5 feet & 4 inches tall, they will report right away to the assembly area.
Note: The Iriga City PNP will provide the Philippine Flag, bearer and two (2) PNP escort.
- During the street parade, FANCY EXECUTION will not be tolerated in-front of the reviewing stand and/or at the competition area.
- After their competition unit passed through the reviewing stand, the band or DBC – Lyre Leader is allowed to give whistle command but to established cadence.
- Each participating school/unit will submit the name of their school head/ commandant and cadets/cadettes officer for announcement by the official emcee while passing the reviewing stand. **The deadline for the submission of ENTRY shall be not later than August 15, 2016 at the City Tourism Office, New Government Center Sta Cruz, Sur Iriga City.**
- The Carriage of rifle should be 11:00 o'clock position and the swing of arms 6:3 degrees.
- Only officials and guests will be allowed to occupy the reviewing stand.
- After the parade, all commandants, corps commanders, band/DBC-Lyre Instructors and Leader specially the Head of School are requested to be at the City Ceremonial Grandstand for the awarding of winners.
- Strictly AFP Rules & Regulations/New Drill Regulations must be followed and or manual for PMT by Col. Baclagon.
- To avoid congestion and/or gap, kindly follow the order of parade which will be published later.
- Civil Security Unit Personnel (CSU), PNP, Intern Students and Military Police (MP's) will be requested to secure / guard the route of the parade especially in Rotary Road, fronting MCM Restaurant and in-front of the BFP Station to Petron Service Center.
- Five points from the total score will be deducted from any who stop or march in place to make adjustment once inside the competing area from BIGG's Diner up to exit area with exception of the Band or DBC – Lyre Corps which shall proceed to the area designated to them while their units is passing the reviewing stand.
- Exhibition of any kind by the competing unit Majorettes/DBC-Lyre of Band shall not be allowed while passing by the reviewing stand in order not to delay the flow of the parade.
- Military parade competition are as follows:
- REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY PARADE COMPETITION

1. Corps Commanders & Staff
2. One (1) Company Commander, One (1) Company Ex-O & One (1) Guidon Bearer;

3. One (1) 1st Platoon Leader (Boys)
4. One (1) 1st Platoon (3x7) for Boys with wooden riffles;
5. One (1) 1st Platoon Leader (Girls)
6. One (1) 2nd Platoon (3x7) for Girls without wooden riffles;
7. No Company Sergeant

CRITERIA FOR COMPETITION OF PMT UNITS (BOYS)

1. Marching	20%
2. Alignment	20%

- Trophies shall be awarded to all lucky winners, likewise, special Leadership Trophies shall be also awarded to Platoon leaders (Boys & Girls) DBC-Lyre Corps Leaders and Majorettes Leaders whose unit are chosen winners after the parade.
- CERTIFICATE OF MERIT shall be awarded at the City Ceremonial Grandstand to participating units, Schools Head and Commandants/Instructors/Instructress right after the parade.
- **THE DECISION OF THE BOARD OF JUDGES IS FINAL**
- Inquiries regarding the result of the competition will be allowed/entertain only right after the announcement of winners at the ceremonial grandstand in the presence of the over-all chairman & Board of Judges. After 20 minutes, the committee will no longer accept complaints regarding these matters.
- Military parade competition are as follows:
CATEGORY 1 – ALL PMT MIXED COMPANY (Boys & Girls) open to all schools.
- **REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY PARADE COMPETITION**
 Category 1 (Mixed company)
 1. Corps Commands & Staff to Lead the Units;
 2. One (1) Company Commander, One (1) Company Ex-O & One (1) Guidon Bearer;
 3. One (1) 1st Platoon Leader (Boys)
 4. One (1) 1st Platoon Sergeant (Boys)
 5. One (1) 1st Platoon (3x7) for Boys with wooden riffles;
 6. One (1) 2nd Platoon Leader (Girls)
 7. One (1) 2nd Platoon Sergeant (Girls)
 8. One (1) 1st Platoon (3x7) for Girls without wooden riffles;
 9. No Company Sergeant

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

Minus Two (2) points from the total score for every incomplete or more elements in a competing units:

If participant only for Boys or Girls in a mixed company

(Example: exclusive schools for boys or girls – the unit can participate with Two (2) platoon and only the first Platoon shall be judged.

Note: Disqualification for providing additional competing platoon.



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DANCE PLATOON

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Participating Units coming from the invited schools.
2. Complete military uniform is required.(Gala or other prescribed CAT uniform)
3. Music background must be in CD/USB only. (Cellphone or any other form of music materials is strictly not allowed during the performance. Variety of music is highly encouraged (medley, remixed is open). Note: MAY TATLONG BEBE is highly discouraged. - Presentation must exude a comic effect.
4. DANCE NUMBER is limited within three to five minutes only including the entrance and exit.
5. No substitution of participants to avoid disqualification.
6. WOODEN RIFLES is a must during the contest. NOTE: You may use any model.
7. The decision of the board of judges is final.
8. COMPOSITION FOR DANCE PLATOON
 - One (1) Platoon leader (Regardless of Rank)
 - One (1) Platoon Sergeant (Regardless of Rank)
 - One (1) Guidon Bearer (Regardless of Rank)
 - One (1) Platoon (3x7) with complete wooden rifles.
 - *1st Squad-BOYS; 2nd Squad-GRILS; 3rd Squad-BOYS
 - Select your best Cadets/Cadettes or all Officers combined.
9. AREA LIMITATION: The actual size at the competing area is limited to a size of a Basketball court.
10. ACTUAL PRACTICE AT THE COMPETING AREA IS NOT ALLOWED (Please avoid Disqualifications)
11. Practice the following for the DANCE PLATOON:
 - a. Presentation of the Platoon to the Chairman of Judges:
 - Platoon in Line in Present Arms
 - No Fancy Execution
 - No Unnecessary Execution

TO FORM THE PLATOON: The Platoon forms the platoon at normal interval, etc.
