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**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 32**

**CREATING THE CITY INTER-AGENCY COUNCIL AGAINST TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (CIACAT-VAWC) OF THE CITY OF IRIGA, DEFINING ITS DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9208 declares that the State shall give the highest priority to the enactment of measures and development of *programs that will promote human dignity*, and mitigate pressures for involuntary migration and servitude of persons to ensure their recovery, rehabilitation, and reintegration. Republic Act No. 9262, on the other hand, underscores the commitment of the State of safeguarding the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect of their human rights and to protect them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security.

**WHEREAS**, these two laws provide stronger mandates and direction to relevant government agencies and stakeholders to immediately address human trafficking and VAWC by organizing Inter-Agency Council (IACs) against trafficking (Section 20 of RA 9208) and VAWC (Section 39 of RA 9262). These Councils are composed of government agencies and selected non-government organizations whose mandates are relevant to VAWC and trafficking. Primarily, these national inter-agency councils are envisioned to serve as the coordinating and monitoring bodies on anti-VAWC and anti-trafficking initiatives, respectively. Their other functions include the development of comprehensive and integrated programs to harmonize all initiatives in addressing these problems, and the creation of enabling mechanisms that shall ensure the full implementation of RAs 9262 and 9208 at the sub-national and local levels.

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and Department of Justice (DOJ) ISSUED Joint Memo Circular No 2010-1 dated 19 October 2010, directing all Local Government Units (LGUs) and Non-Government Agencies (NGAs) to create Local Council Against Trafficking – Violence Against Women and Children (LCAT-VAWC), for the effective implementation of RA 9268 and RA 9262 and in the prevention and monitoring of trafficking and VAWC cases at the local level.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, MADELAINE YOROBE ALFELOR**, Local Chief Executive of Iriga City by virtue of the powers vested on me by the law, do order the following:

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.** Organization of City Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children of Iriga City, Province of Camarines Sur shall be composed of:

SECTION 2. **FUNCTIONS.** The functions of the City Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children (CIACAT-VAWC) are as follows:

2.1. Institute policies and programs to protect women and children who are victims of trafficking and violence by recommending local ordinances and resolutions;

2.2. Create and establish systems on surveillance, investigation and rescue to ensure effective and efficient coordination;

2.3. Undertake information, education, and advocacy campaign against trafficking in persons and VAWC;

2.4 Monitor and oversee the strict implementation of RA 9208 and RA 9262, and other related laws for the protection of women and children;

2.5. Implement the programs and activities as stated in the national plan of action of CIACAT-VAWC.


SECTION 3. **CIACAT-VAWC SECRETARIAT.** The CIACAT-VAWC Secretariat shall be designated to provide technical and administrative support and other assistance that may be required by the council.

SECTION 4. **BUDGET.** The amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (₱250,000.00) Pesos to be taken from GAD fund and/or any available fund of the city, shall be allocated to finance the operation of the council.

SECTION 5. **MEETINGS.** The Council shall meet regularly every quarter at any date that shall be determined by the council members.

SECTION 6. **EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
